Background

- Modernize of fare collection system
- LANTA has not increased its base fare in almost 18 years.
- Base fare is \$2.00
- LANTA must follow Act 89 provisions
- An increase was planned in 2020
- Adjustments are needed to keep pace with inflation and maintain a sustainable system.



Proposed Fare Structure

Current Structure

Product	Price
Single Ride	\$2.00
3-Hour Pass	\$2.00
Transfer	\$2.25
Reduced Fare	\$1.00
ADA Base Fare*	\$4.40
Day Pass	\$4.00
31 – Day Pass	\$60.00

Proposed Structure

Product	Price
Single Ride	\$2.50
3-Hour Pass	\$2.50
Transfer	Eliminated
Reduced Fare	\$1.25
ADA Base Fare*	\$4.50
Day Pass	\$5.00
31 – Day Pass	\$70.00

- **25%:** Single ride, 3-hour, Reduced-fare, and Day pass.
- **16.67%:** 31-Day pass
- **2.27%:** Paratransit ADA Base Fare



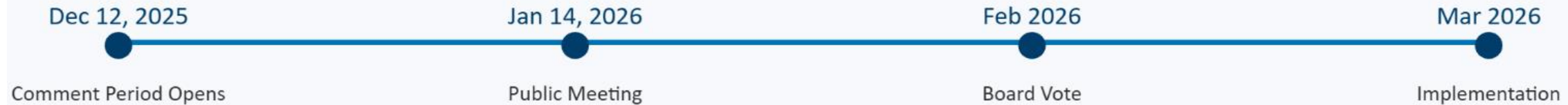
Elimination of Physical Transfers

Year	Transfer Percentage of Total Ridership
2022	0.2%
2023	0.2%
2024	0.5%
2025	0.6%
