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**RESOLUTION BY BOARD OF DIRECTORS RECOGNIZING
EBS BUS RAPID TRANSIT FUNDING**

THE UNDERSIGNED, being the duly authorized Secretary of the municipal authority known as Lehigh and Northampton Transportation Authority, and existing under the laws of the state of Pennsylvania, hereby certifies that the following Resolution was passed by the governing body of said authority at a meeting of the authority duly called and convened on August 18, 2026:

RESOLVED, that recognizing LANTA's EBS Bus Rapid Transit project as a primary service development goal of the Authority, LANTA is hereby dedicating \$2.2 Million in Capital funding toward the continued development of EBS Corridor and Station Development in FY 2027. Additionally, as part of LANTA's adopted operating budget for its fixed route operations, \$14.8 million will be expended on EBS Bus Rapid Transit operations in FY 2027.
